Celebrating and Learning about Autism - April is a month of raising awareness of Autism and as a school we will continue with our teaching and learning about Autism. Yr 7-9 Examinations: These will be held during the period 12 to 16 May during the morning session for Yrs 7-9, with National Numeracy and Reading Tests held in school during the period 2-13 June. Please ensure your child is present in school during these periods.

Road Safety – We are delighted that finally, stricter no parking regulations are now in force at the school gates. This has significantly increased safety standards. However, we remain concerned regarding the large number of parents who feel it appropriate to stop in this area in order to drop off their child directly in front of the school gates. **Please park your car away from this area and your son / daughter can then walk a short distance to the school entrance**. This illegal stopping and parking is a real hazard to the large number of pupils who cycle to school and are forced to swerve or make detour around parked vehicles.
