Deepest sympathies: It is with great sadness that we heard of the unexpected passing of Mr Dylan Hughes, Headteacher of Ysgol Gynradd Gymraeg Nant Caerau over the half term break. Mr Hughes was formerly a teacher at Ysgol Bro Eirwg and Ysgol Pen y Garth, Deputy Head at Ysgol Pwll Coch and appointed Head at Ysgol Nant Caerau since its opening in September 2010. He was an extremely dedicated and well-respected leader, wholly committed to the pupils and wider community of Nant Caerau and a pioneering and inspirational Head within the city and Welsh-medium education sector. We send our most sincere condolences to his family and the wider community who feel his passing with such great loss.

Eisteddfod Sir yr Urdd: This year's Eisteddfod Sir will be held on **28 March** at the All Nations Centre. All Yr 7-9 competitions will be held in the morning and all Yr 10-13 competitions in the afternoon. A letter has been sent on Classcharts to those pupils competing individually and/or as a member of a group/choir with further details. **If your child is competing individually the preliminaries will be held on 26** March at **Ysgol Glantaf from 4pm. The Urdd will send us the order of competition and details in due course.** The Eisteddfod Sir for Theatre competitions will be held on **1 April** at Cardiff University's Students' Union.

School Uniform: All pupils are aware of Glantaf's school uniform rules and standards – the rules can be clearly found on the school website <u>School Uniform | Ysgol Gyfun Gymraeg Glantaf</u> and in the pupils' Contact Books. Unfortunately, an increasing number of pupils have started to ignore these rules. We kindly ask for your support to ensure your child does not deviate from our standards –

- NO black trousers; NO jeans style; NO leggings.
- NO white socks plain navy or black socks ONLY.
- NO hoodies of any type.
- A hairstyle acceptable to the school; NO unnatural colours, lines or patterns.
- One pair of earrings plain studs in both ears, NO hoops.
- NO jewellery at all; NO necklace/chain/bracelet/nose stud.
- SUBTLE make up only. NO nail colour/nail extension/false eyelashes.

If a pupil continues to breach the school rules, sanctions will be put in place in adherence with our school policy.

Year 7 one-to-one device: The school has decided to continue to offer a chromebook device to all current year 7 pupils (Year 8 September 2025) by December 2025. Due to budget difficulties, Cardiff Council are unable to continue to fund this scheme but we hope that with parents' support it can be continued. We will send you a letter in the next few weeks, and an online meeting will be held soon to explain the scheme.
